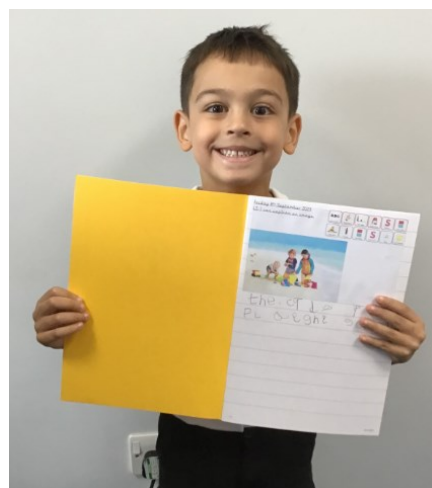
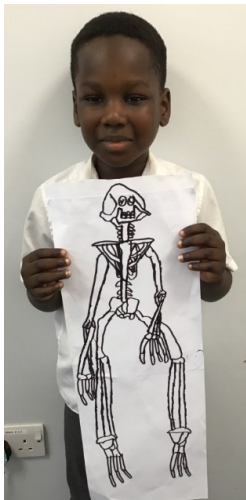
Clubs start next week
